






Sign up to help during Worship!

Sherry opened the meeting at 6:00 pm with devotion & prayer. Present were Caitlin Bentzinger, Sherry Hake, Jan Hake, Kevin Pearson, Jon Moyer and Gretta Mewis.

Minutes were read & accepted from previous meeting with no corrections. Treasurer report was presented & accepted. Trustees:

Old business: Thrasher is scheduled for the work at the church on April 1st & 2nd. There is work to do before they come (move stuff out of elevator room, Sunday School room & furnace room). Going to ask Thrasher if the work can be postponed for a week or two. Jon reported on DWB's assessment of the parsonage wall. There is a small crack in the wall under the window. Dwb's opinion is that we could leave it alone or place wall stiffeners. We need to ask for a written assessment from dwb. We are waiting on a 3rd bid from Steve Krings before making a final decision.

DWB did suggest that the North station of the sprinkler system be disabled. Tyler said he will work on disabling that station. It is too close to the problem wall of the parsonage. (North side of house)


Ad Board:

Today, her program spans 5 countries and gifts over 1 million free books each month to children around the world. They dream of becoming a doctor or an inventor or a minister. Who knows, maybe there is a little girl whose dream is to be a writer and singer. Sue S. handed out the treasurer report, we went over it and it was placed on file. The audit is done and has been sent in. We requested that the trustees look into our funds that is held at Nebr. United Methodist foundation. The trustees reported that after receiving another report it was looking all ok.

New Business:
